### Playground update

- Earthwrights due to start phase 1 on 16<sup>th</sup> June. Work likely to take 2 weeks to complete.
- Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> June demolition of the old fort to commence – ‘Demolition Dads’ – Will leading a small team of skilled Dads. Possibly on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> a second group – more of a community day where others can come and help with secondary clearing of the pieces that have been demolished.
- Action for Becky – ask Parish council for love your playground ‘jobs’ for people to do.
- There will be hedges fencing to cordon off the area whilst work is being undertaken.
- Hoping to be able to commence phase 2 in spring 2026.
- Anna has applied for 2 grants - £10000 and £15000 – will take 6-10 weeks to hear back from this. We need a total of £50000.
- Possibility of some council money that could be accessed to contribute – Nick and Jess exploring this with local councillor.
- Plan to review funds in September and commence further fundraising as required.
- Discussion about a sign/plaque to go up in the playground to say funded by PTFA – showing phase 1 and what is to come in phase 2.
